The Learning Program (LP) – based on 30 years of research, LP instruction improves the academic success of children with Down syndrome and teaches their parents to be effective first teachers

Relationships – based on James Stanfield's award winning Circles® curriculum, Relationships teaches social boundaries and relationship skills to promote safety and vocational training

DSANV Cooking Club – based on Janice Goldschmidt's award winning book, *Teaching Authentic Cooking Skills to Adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities: Active Engagement*, the Cooking Club meets in person, and virtually, to learn how to make healthy food choices, how to promote food safety and how to engage families in cooking together

DSANV Book Club – launched in 2021, the Book Club engages school aged students and adults in reading, responding to questions and participating in relevant activities; we host a weekly summer reading program plus winter and spring break reading challenges prepared by a Special Education teacher

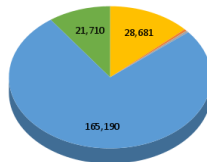
Champion Football – friendly games played in modified flag football style encourage teamwork and inclusivity and provide a safe and fun environment to experience the excitement of team football
